Aims of Vera Street Community Garden Inc.

The Aims of the Association are stated in the model rules as the Objects of the Association and these provide a guide to what we are wanting to achieve and how we will act as a group. New members need to be aware of these before joining.

1. To create and maintain a sustainable community garden on environmentally aware principles.
2. To conduct habitat protection and Creek Rehabilitation at Toowong Creek.
3. To provide an opportunity for school and community interaction through Toowong College.
4. To foster inter-generational and inter-cultural relationships in the local community.
5. To provide the opportunity for marginalised community members to participate in community activities.
6. To revitalise existing knowledge about gardening and native bush regeneration within the inner city suburbs.
7. To provide a link with the garden's historical roots as a Chinese market Garden and its Indigenous heritage.

Code of Conduct

Members of the garden should act to build and maintain a tolerant, respectful, harmonious and inclusive community through exercising personal integrity and acting with the groups best interests in mind.

In our garden there is sharing of produce, knowledge, wisdom and friendship.

Child members at the garden are the responsibility of their accompanying adult members, although we will all endeavour to make the garden a safe and welcoming place for children.

Visitors to the garden are required to be respectful of our code of conduct.
